## Harper rams omnibus Bill C-4 through Parliament

The Harper government has pushed another massive omnibus bill through Parliament that is sure to have detrimental impacts on future negotiations in the federal public service, as well as setbacks to the Canada Labour Code which will impact on our ability to resolve health and safety issues for correctional officers in the workplace.

Although Bill C-4 is now passed as law, some sections of this legislation will only be implemented over the coming months.

We are working with the CSN legal department to challenge the legislation as it comes into effect. As always, we will ensure that our membership is fully informed of proceedings we launch.
