Many times, events at work would lead them to be upset which would make us feel distant from each other whilst trying to deal what they were going through.

Amongst all the negative aspects this experience has brought, my parents have shown me the benefits of having the Union in place. Some examples include, protecting employees by making sure their needs are met. They help make sure people like my parents are able to time

off when they need to. The Union also will host annual events so that they can remain connected, to maintain good relationships outside of work. Overall in my experience, the Union has personally helped me and my family and I am thankful for their actions.

In conclusion, the UCCO SACC Union has impacted my home life in positive and negative ways. From impacting family time and relationships to bringing members together, the Union has continued to prove its importance to its employees and also their families.
